This profession continues to be targeted by HMRC following the previous Amnesty as there is significant potential lost revenue to the exchequer. Mileage claims and undeclared commissions tend to be the focus of attention.



Plumbers

Following information received from external sources, HMRC has launched an Amnesty for Plumbers allowing them to make disclosures relating to unpaid taxes. However, once the Amnesty is over, it is likely that HMRC will target this industry for investigation.



Cash Trades

Businesses that handle cash transactions tend to be typical targets for enquiry work due to the potential for inaccuracies. Over the years, HMRC has generated significant income from a variety of businesses that fall into this category.

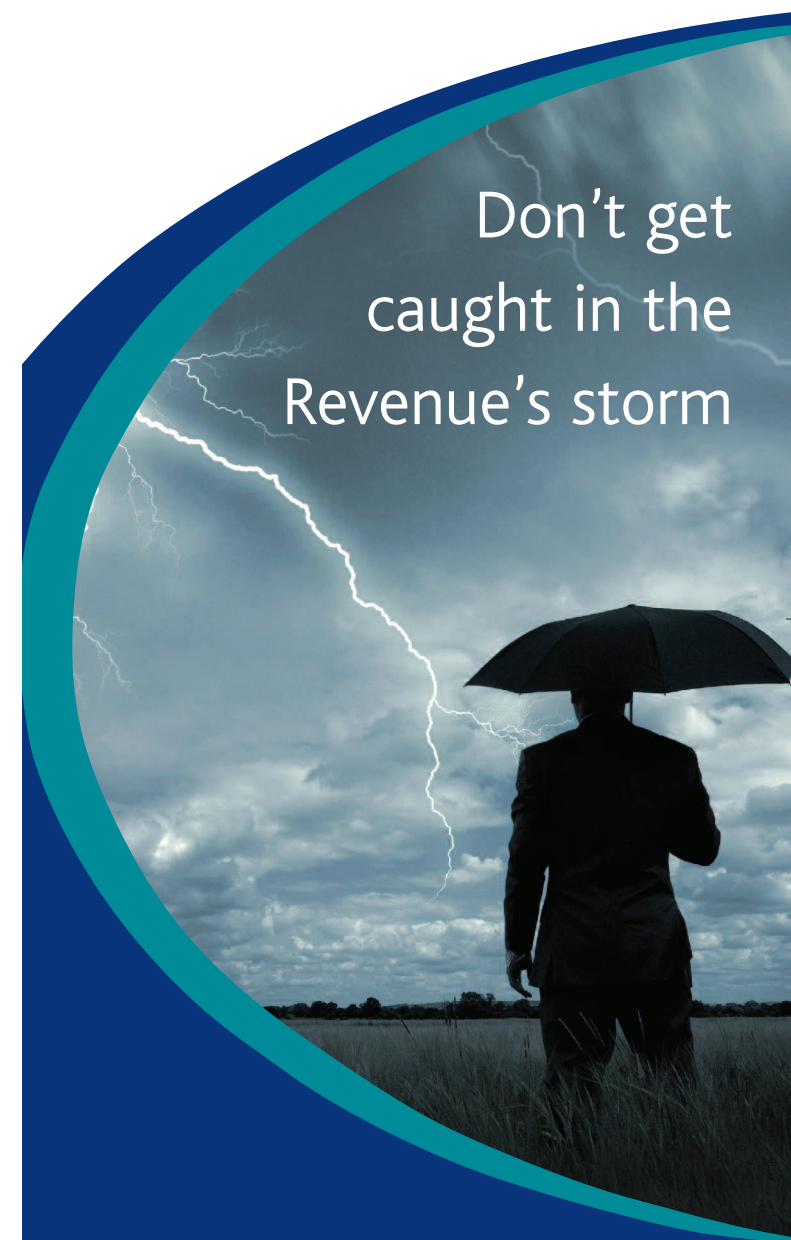
