









Q. Would you have preferred the UK to go for a 'Hard Brexit'







Divorce Bill

Q. Would you have preferred the UK to go for a 'Hard Brexit' at the time of the Brexit vote?










Who do you think will negotiate the better deal - David Davis or Michel Barnier?




Do you think the EU are behaving fairly or unfairly in the negotiations?



■ Don't know (13%) ■ Fairly (40%) ■ Unfairly (47%)


Do you think that after Brexit having no hard border between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland would be workable?







Do you think the UK economy over the next decade will do better or worse as a result of Breixt?










Geographical spread of respondents
